### News from our French visitors, Adrien and Gwladys Broult

EARLIER THIS YEAR LIONS ADRIEN AND GWLADYS BROULT FROM THE HELEN KELLER CLUB, PARIS, SPENT SOME OF THEIR HONEYMOON IN HAVELOCK, AND WE WERE WONDERING HOW THEY FARED. HERE IS THE END OF THEIR STORY: OUR RETURN HAS BEEN JUST IN TIME BEFORE THE QUARANTINE IN FRANCE. WE LEFT NEW ZEALAND ON THE SATURDAY EVENING AND ARRIVED SUNDAY AT LUNCH TIME IN FRANCE. WE ARRIVED AT OUR FLAT IN THE AFTERNOON, TIME TO UNPACK, SEE BOTH OUR MOTHERS FOR DINNER AND GET OUR CAT BACK AFTER 3 WEEKS AT GWLADYS'S MOTHER HOME. WE WERE HEARING RUMORS OF A QUARANTINE STARTING ON TUESDAY JUST AFTER OUR PRESIDENT'S SPEECH ON MONDAY EVENING. WE BOTH WORKED FROM HOME AS OUR COMPANIES TOLD US SO. AFTER THREE WEEKS OF HONEYMOON WE WERE TO SEE OUR COLLEAGUES, BUT WE HAD TO WAIT. WE MOVED IN RECENTLY SO OUR FLAT ISN'T YET PROPERLY READY FOR HOME OFFICE WORK. WE DECIDED NOT TO WAIT FOR THE PRESIDENT SPEECH AND DROVE WITH MY MOTHER TO BRITANY WHERE WE HAVE A FAMILY HOUSE. WE FINALLY STAYED A DAY IN OUR FLAT AND PACKED AGAIN.

BRITANY IS A REGION I'M SURE NEW ZEALANDERS WOULD LOVE, A COUNTRY PROUD OF ITS ORIGIN AND ITS LAND. WE TRY TO BE THE CLOSEST TO THE NATURE AND WE WANT TO TAKE CARE OF IT. LOTS OF BEACH AND SEA AND WE HAVE MANY GOOD DISHES TO EAT. I COULDN'T RECOMMEND ONE PLACE PARTICULAR BECAUSE THEY ARE TOO MANY AND SOME I STILL HAVEN'T VISITED YET. WE DID OUR QUARANTINE IN MY HOME. GWLADYS STOPPED WORKING SINCE BEGINNING OF APRIL BUT STILL IS OCCUPIED WITH GETTING OUR WEDDING, HONEYMOON PICTURES PRINTED AND CREATING ALBUMS OF THE PAST YEARS. WE WERE LUCKY TO HAVE A BEAUTIFUL WEATHER SO THERE WAS A LOT OF GARDENING. DURING THE EVENING, WE HAVE FOR THE OCCASION A FRENCH COOK WHO CREATED A SHOW ON TV WHERE YOU CAN ACTUALLY COOK WITH HIM AND AFTER 50MINUTES, YOUR DINNER IS READY. A NICE HABIT AND HELPING US TO STAY FIT.

WE ALSO HAD OUR CROSSFIT BOX, WHICH CREATED A DAILY EXERCISE SO WE COULD KEEP TRAINING AND ALSO STAY FIT IF WE HAD EATEN TOO MUCH CHOCOLATE IN FRONT WITH OUR TEA. THE PROXIMITY WITH THE SEA GAVE US THE POSSIBILITY TO HAVE OUR DAILY FISH AND WE WEREN'T COOKING WITH CYRIL LIGNAC (THE FRENCH COOK ON TV). TO BE FAIR, WE WERE MUCH MORE LUCKIER THAN ALL THE FRENCH PEOPLE IN QUARANTINE IN BIG CITIES. WE HAD A BIG HOUSE WITH A GARDEN AND SPACE AND MANY ACTIVITIES TO DO. NOW IN 10 DAYS BACK TO PARIS, WE WILL SEE HOW WE DEAL WITH THE "OLD" LIFE OF A BIG CITY BUT IT IS TRUE WE ENJOYED A LOT LEAVING IN A PLACE WITH SPACE, GARDEN AND SO MUCH CALM. THE QUARANTINE FINALLY BROUGHT US TO THINK A BIT MORE OF OUR LIVES IN PARIS AND WHAT WE ACTUALLY REALLY WANTED FOR THE FUTURE.

#### LCIF report

Members of Lions Clubs often question why we give to the International foundation as they believe charity begins at home.

The Foundation was set up 50 years ago to assist with larger Club projects by granting Dollar for Dollar with a club contribution. As we well know it also assists with Disaster relief.

I have often referred to the fact that the top half of the South Island being our District 202E has received over 4 times the value of donations by way of grants from the Foundation than the value funds donated by Clubs in the District.

As at the 23<sup>rd</sup> April Lions Clubs International foundation has awarded 121 grants totalling \$US2,629,405.00 to Covid -19 Frontline relief. This equates to \$NZ 3,944,107.50.



The reason I mention this is that we can make our funds go further should qualifying projects/causes arise in our area. If we identify a project or cause or should we experience a relapse of Covid-19 later this year we have an opportunity to apply for a dollar for dollar grant thereby doubling the effectiveness of our funds. This is provided we meet the criteria.

Donations to the Australian Bush Fire Appeal have been gratefully received in Australia and when Australian Lions are able to move around again we are assured of receiving reports of how the funds have been used.

As you all know 100% of any donation goes to the designated cause and Lions Clubs International have worked hard to distribute donations to those in need of assistance not unlike some International disaster Relief Organisations who are

still holding large percentages of donations they received. Lions are proud of their efforts and I ask you spread these facts among your neighbours and friends. Any member of the public can donate funds to LCIF for the foundations causes and be assured 100% goes to the cause but all Lions need to promote this fact.
