**3<sup>RD</sup> MARCH 2020**

# WHAT ELSE IS GOING ON IN LIONS...

## A Partnership to Fight Childhood Cancer in Africa

In developing countries, as few as 10 percent of children with cancer survive. More than 80 percent survive in developed countries. The difference is astounding, but Lions can change this. To strengthen local healthcare in Uganda, Malawi, and Botswana and save more lives, LCIF is collaborating with Global HOPE, a program from Texas Children's Hospital and Baylor College of Medicine.

The LCIF Board of Trustees approved a 2-year strategic partnership between LCIF and Global HOPE to cooperate in building long-term capacity in Africa to treat and dramatically improve the prognosis for children with cancer and blood disorders in Sub-Saharan Africa. This partnership will help strengthen the local healthcare infrastructure to effectively provide the multi-disciplinary care that is needed to optimally care for children with cancer and blood disorders.

The partnership includes three components:

1. LCIF funding support of US\$2 million over 2 years to support Global HOPE infrastructure, strengthening projects in Uganda, Malawi, and Botswana.
2. Engagement of local Lions at the country level in Global HOPE activities within their country.
3. Joint fundraising where financial support is mobilized for the partnership.
