THE KAKA AT NATURELAND. HERE WE SEE A COUPLE OF PIECES OF DRIFTWOOD WHICH HAVE HAD



LIONS CLUBS BEGAN IN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA IN 1917. A GROUP OF INDEPENDENT CLUBS RESPONDED TO A CALL FROM A YOUNG CHICAGO INSURANCE AGENT, MELVIN JONES, TO LAUNCH A CLUB WHICH HAD COMMUNITY SERVICE AS ITS PRIME AIM.

THE FIRST NEW ZEALAND LIONS CLUB WAS FORMED IN 1955 IN AUCKLAND. FROM THIS HAS GROWN TO NEARLY 500 CLUBS, WITH A MEMBERSHIP OF ALMOST 14,000. WORLDWIDE THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF LIONS CLUBS HAS A MEMBERSHIP OF APPROXIMATELY 1.4 MILLION IN 193 COUNTRIES AND GEOGRAPHICAL AREAS.

20TH FEBRUARY 1945 - 12TH APRIL 2020

On 16^{TH} May 2017 Jan Osborne was made an Honorary Member of our Club. This was the first time in our 51 years that such an award had been given.

PDG JOHN RODGER MADE THE AWARD AND HIS OUTLINE OF THE TREMENDOUS CONTRIBUTION MADE BY JAN TO THE HAVELOCK COMMUNITY WAS IMPRESSIVE. NOT ONLY WAS SHE CLOSELY ASSOCIATED WITH OUR CLUB (THE MEALS SHE MADE WHEN THE CLUB MET IN THE TOWN HALL ARE LEGENDARY!) BUT SHE HELPED WITH LION PROJECTS LIKE REVAMPING THE OLD JETTY AND RENOVATING THE OLD TOILETS.

MOST FACETS OF VILLAGE LIFE HAVE BENEFITTED FROM HER HUGE HEART, FOR INSTANCE SHE HELPED GET GUIDES ESTABLISHED, TRAINED AS A PARAMEDIC, CLEANED AND LOOKED AFTER THE HALL, WAS INVOLVED WITH THE FIRE FIGHTERS, PROVIDED SHELTER FOR DISTRESSED PEOPLE WHEN ASKED TO DO SO BY THE POLICE AND, OF COURSE, CATERED FOR ANZAC DAY PARTICIPANTS FOR 12 YEARS.

ALTHOUGH SHE HAD MADE DONATIONS TO THE COMMUNITY GARDEN SINCE IT BEGAN IN 2011, THIS YEAR SHE BECAME A REGULAR VOLUNTEER THERE ON A TUESDAY WHEN SHE LEARNT OF THE LACK OF VOLUNTEERS. HER GARDENING KNOWLEDGE AND THE HOURS SHE PUT IN WERE GREATLY APPRECIATED.

JAN SAYS HER PROUDEST ACHIEVEMENT IS TO HAVE THREE GREAT KIDS AND POINTED OUT THAT RAY WAS HER PARTNER IN ALL SHE DID.

JAN WILL BE GREATLY MISSED ACROSS A WIDE SECTOR OF THE COMMUNITY. REST IN PEACE, JAN. YOU WILL NOT BE EASILY FORGOTTEN.
